COMES NOW, Ken Grace, the Chief of Police of the City of Ardmore, Oklahoma, and alleges and states as follows:

1. The Ardmore Police Department has come into the possession of certain personal property, to be described in detail hereinafter, the owner of which is unknown, or who has not claimed the property, the property has been in custody of the Chief of Police for at least ninety (90) days and the property is no longer needed to be held as evidence or for any other purpose in connection with any litigation.
2. Attached to this Application and made a part hereof is a list describing the personal property which includes any identifying numbers and marks, and the date that the property came into possession of the Chief of Police. The names of the owners or persons in last possession of this property, and their addresses, are set out on the list or are unknown.
3. The Chief of Police requests the authority of the Court to conduct a sale of such personal property, to donate or to destroy any property having a value of less than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) in accordance with 11 O.S. §34-104 (D).

4. Any guns or deadly weapons listed in the attached list of property shall not be sold, but will either be destroyed or returned to lawful owners.

WHEREFORE, the Applicant prays that the Court set this matter for hearing not less than ten (10) days nor more than twenty (20) days after the filing of this Application, and that after the hearing, that this Court grant the Applicant the authority to conduct a sale, donate or destroy the personal property described in the attached list, and for such other and further relief as the Court deems equitable.

**ORDER AUTHORIZING SALE, DONATION OR DESTRUCTION OF PROPERTY**

THIS MATTER, comes on for hearing this 27<sup>th</sup> day of SEPT., 2019, on the Application of the Chief of Police of the City of Ardmore, Oklahoma, seeking authority to sell, donate or destroy personal property which has come into his possession. The Applicant appears in person. No one appears in opposition. The Court proceeded to examine the Notice and finds that the Notice of Hearing has been given according to the requirements of 11 O.S. §34-104.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED, by the Court that the Chief of Police is authorized to sell, donate or destroy the personal property for cash to the highest bidder after at least five (5) days' notice of the date, time, and place of the sale has been published in the Daily Ardmoreite. The Chief of Police shall make a return of the sale. The Order of the Court confirming this sale shall vest title to the property in the purchaser.
