Shooting Victim Recovering

On Monday evening shortly before nine o'clock, 24-year old Billy Sanders was shot in front of a residence in the 600 block of 4th SW in Ardmore. The shooting occurred after a dispute between the victim and another man, 25-year old Jamie Cleo Thompson. Investigators believe Thompson left the scene and then returned a short time later with the gunman, 19-year old Ronald Cline Brown – also known as "Pee-Wee." Brown got out of the car, produced a handgun, and then fired two shots, one of which struck Sanders in the abdomen. Sanders was rushed to a local hospital where he underwent surgery and is now recovering. At last check, he was listed in stable condition. The nature of the dispute which led to the shooting is unknown, and is currently under investigation.

The prime suspect is 19-year old Ronald Cline Brown, and is described as a white male, 5'11" 170 pounds with brown hair and hazel eyes. Brown fled the scene immediately following the shooting, and is still at large. He is considered armed and dangerous.

A second suspect is also being sought in connection with the shooting. 25-year old Jamie Cleo Thompson is believed to have played a role in the crime, and is described as a black male, approximately 6'2", 175 pounds, with a medium build.
