Suspects Sought in Pharmacy Burglary

Ardmore Police are asking for the public's help in discovering the identity or whereabouts of the person or persons responsible for the burglary of the Tigert Pharmacy at approximately two o'clock Tuesday morning, February 24. The individuals gained entry by compromising the locking mechanism on the front door of the business. They stole a large amount of hydrocodone pain tablets from the pharmacy shelves and then fled the scene.

Detectives have discovered similarities between this crime and other pharmacy burglaries that recently took place in Durant, Oklahoma, Bonham, Texas, and Denison, Texas. The Durant incident occurred on January 2, 2009 and the suspects were recorded on visual surveillance equipment. Detectives believe there may be a connection between the Ardmore burglary and the Durant, Bonham, and Denison crimes.

The Durant Police have provided APD Detectives with surveillance photos from the January 2nd case. The suspects pictured are considered persons of interest in the Ardmore pharmacy burglary. If anyone has any information as to the identity or whereabouts of either of the individuals pictured, you are asked to contact the Ardmore Police Department Investigative Services Division at 221-2521.
