Persons of Interest Sought in Pharmacy Case

On Monday, March 9, 2009, shortly after 3:30am, Ardmore Police Dispatch was notified of an intrusion alarm at the Henry Roberts Express Pharmacy in the 1300 block of Northwest 12th Avenue. Officers arrived at the business moments later and discovered that the east door of the business had been forced open. A large amount of prescription drugs was taken, including the pain medication hydrocodone. The suspect had already fled the scene by the time police arrived.

Surveillance video reveals the suspect in this case as a white or Hispanic male, wearing a black hoodie, blue jeans, and gloves. He may have been accompanied by two other individuals who did not enter the pharmacy. All three subjects were traveling in a newer model pickup truck, dark color over silver.

A store receipt was discovered outside the pharmacy which led detectives to a 24-hour retail store in North Ardmore. Surveillance video from that location shows two people making a purchase and exiting the store. Investigators believe those individuals have knowledge of the crime at Henry Roberts Express Pharmacy, and are considering them persons of interest. They are described as an Hispanic male and a white female, both in their 20's.
