Suspected Teenage Dealers Busted by APD Narcotics Unit

Ardmore Police Narcotics Investigators shut down two separate marijuana operations on Monday, March 9th. Both cases involved suspected teenage “dealers.”

A 17-year old white female was detained after police executed a search warrant at a home in the 600 block of 4th Southeast Monday morning. Officers discovered scales, baggies, pipes, and partially smoked marijuana cigarettes. The young lady was released to her mother pending charges of possession of marijuana and paraphernalia. Two-hundred dollars in cash was seized along with the other evidence. The case has been turned over to juvenile authorities and the District Attorney’s office.

In a separate case, a 17-year old Hispanic male was detained after officers executed a search warrant at an apartment in the 100 block of Monroe Northeast. Two other teenagers were also in the apartment. Almost a half pound of marijuana was discovered as a result of the search, and more than \$700 in cash. Scales and baggies were also found, and officers believe they were being used to distribute the drug. The juvenile was released to his mother pending charges of possession of marijuana with intent to distribute.

Neither of the suspected dealers was employed. “This seemed like a day of juveniles who are in the drug business,” said narcotics investigator Sgt. Kevin Norris.
