Man Assaulted, Robbed in Hotel Room

On Sunday, April 5, 2009, at approximately 1:45am, Ardmore Police responded to call at a hotel in the 2700 block of Southwest Broadway. Upon arrival, a 43-year old hotel guest told police he had been beaten and robbed inside his room by people he did not know.

The victim stated that a white female knocked on his hotel room door and asked if she could use the telephone inside the room. The victim allowed the female inside, at which time another older female came in behind the first female, also asking to use the phone. The victim told police a black male then came into the room and yelled at the victim, demanding his wallet be turned over.

The victim, who provided a Georgia address, said he was then assaulted by the unidentified man. The victim managed to run out of the room but his wallet was taken by the assailant, who made off with an undisclosed amount of cash.

The suspects are described as a white female in her mid-twenties, a white female 35-40 years of age, approximately 5'5" tall and weighing 205 pounds with long grayish blonde hair and wearing blue jeans and a white t-shirt, and a black male with a goatee, 25-30 years old weighing 250-300 pounds and wearing a white track suit with red stripes. The suspects left the hotel in a late 90's model Cadillac or similar vehicle. It is not believed the suspects were guests at the hotel.

Another hotel guest reported being disturbed by a white female knocking on his door also asking to come inside, but he did not admit the woman.

Citizens are urged to use caution when deciding whether to allow strangers into their homes or lodging. If you feel something is out of place, or feel threatened at anytime, call the police.
