Man Arrested on Drug Charges

On Tuesday, April 7, 2009, Ardmore Police Narcotics officers, Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics agents, Carter County Sheriff's Deputies, and Chickasaw Nation LightHorse Police officers executed a search warrant at a home in the 200 block of 12th Southeast in Ardmore. Upon entering the residence, officers discovered approximately 2 pounds of marijuana with an estimated street value of \$1,500.

46-year old Kevin Wayne Halstied lived at the residence, and was arrested pending charges of Possession of Marijuana With Intent to Distribute.

This operation was initiated with information obtained from a Marietta Police Officer. The officer passed along the information that resulted in additional investigation leading to the issuance of a search warrant for Halstied's residence.

Halstied has been arrested in the past for drug offenses.

"This was a great effort on the part of all agencies involved. We really appreciate the effort put forth by our colleagues from assisting agencies which ultimately led to an arrest in this case," said Cpl. Keith Ingle, Ardmore Police Narcotics investigator.
