Pharmacy Tip Leads to Arrests

Ardmore Police Narcotics officers, assisted by the Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics, Carter County Sheriff's Deputies, and Chickasaw Nation LightHorse Police officers, arrested two individuals on Monday, April 6, 2009. The arrests were made after the suspects purchased pseudoephedrine products at a local pharmacy at approximately 1:30pm. Pharmacy personnel then alerted authorities, as the subject who made the purchase was flagged as a frequent buyer of such products.

The two purchased additional pseudoephedrine products a short time later at another local pharmacy, after which a traffic stop was initiated near the intersection of West Broadway and Commerce. 35-year old Anthony Todd Barnes and 37-year old Rodney Earl Doss were arrested pending charges of Attempting to Possess Methamphetamine. Both men reside in Healdton, Oklahoma. Additionally, Doss was found to have three outstanding Jefferson County Warrants.

Cookware was also found in the vehicle which tested positive for pseudoephedrine residue. Barnes and Doss were transported and booked into the Carter County Jail.
