Pharmacy Targeted a Second Time

On Sunday, April 26, 2009, at approximately 9:45pm, officers responded to a burglary alarm at the Tigert Pharmacy in the 2000 block of Southwest Broadway (Tiffany Plaza). The pharmacy door was found to be forced open, but nothing inside the business had been taken. Officers noticed a white Toyota Land Cruiser with custom wheels leaving the area as they initially approached the shopping center.

In addition to the Land Cruiser spotted by a responding officer, witnesses reported seeing a silver Volkswagen Jetta parked near the pharmacy entrance. Two individuals were seen getting out of the Jetta and walking around the building, but were not seen entering the business. The witness could not provide a description of the individuals.

Surrounding law enforcement agencies were notified to be on heightened alert for possible burglary attempts at their local pharmacies. Pharmacy owners are advised to ensure adequate and reasonable security measures are in place at their business. In last night's case, it is believed that additional security measures instituted by pharmacy management thwarted the criminals' plans to steal narcotics.

Both the Land Cruiser and the Jetta are being considered vehicles of interest in the ongoing investigation into pharmacy burglaries in the region. Anybody with information about any of the recent pharmacy burglaries are asked to call Ardmore CrimeStoppers anonymously at 580-504-4LAW.
