Man Arrested at Local Motel

On Wednesday, April 29, 2009, at around 11:45am, APD officers were dispatched to Motel 6 in the 100 block of Holiday Drive. Motel employees contacted police dispatch after a disturbance broke out in the parking lot area between a female and another individual, both believed to be guests at the hotel.

When officers arrived, they made contact with 25-year old Wyoming Jewel Perry of Ardmore, whom officers believed was involved in the disturbance. Perry allowed officers into his room to speak with a 16-year old female companion about what had taken place in the parking lot.

Upon entering the room, Sgt. Randall Williams and Cpl. Josh McGee discovered evidence of marijuana in plain sight. Additional observations would lead to the discovery of six pounds two ounces of packaged marijuana, along with \$1,600 in cash, electronic scales, and baggies. Perry was placed under arrest and transported to the Carter County Jail pending charges of possession of marijuana with intent to distribute. The juvenile female was released to her parents.

The estimated street value of the seized marijuana is \$3,000. Carter County Deputies assisted Ardmore PD officers at the scene.
